Directions to open up PDF Portfolios

Follow this steps to view pdfs in portfolio using Adobe Reader.

- 1. Open the portfolio.pdf file in Adobe Reader.
- 2. Select View, Portfolio and check Details from the main menu. A search box will appear on the top right. Enter the letter 'a', click on the down arrow beside the binoculars and select "Search Entire Portfolio'. Click the binocular icon.
- 3. All the embedded pdf files will appear in the window. You can change the sort preference to "by filename" and extend the search window.
- 4. Click on the pdf file to view.

For you information I use "a" as a wildcard.

Firefox:

To fix this and use the Adobe Reader plugin: Tools | Options | tab Applications change (Portable Document Format)

to (click on the Action part on that line to get the pull-down menu)

Now the PDF document displays correctly in the Adobe Reader plugin

Chrome:

To turn off the Chrome PDF viewer, follow these steps:

- 1. Install Adobe Reader or Adobe Acrobat if it is not already installed
- 2. Open Google Chrome
- In the address bar, type . . .
 about:plugins
 (that's the word about a colon (:), then plugins



- 4. The Plug-ins Tab will open
- Scroll down until you see either Adobe Acrobat or Reader. Click the Enable link
- 6. Close the Plug-ins tab and restart Chrome
